



Independent Women Supports The Keep Our Girls Safe Act

Dear Members of Congress,

Independent Women applauds the introduction of the Keep Our Girls Safe Act by Representative Mary Miller. Independent Women fights for women and their loved ones by effectively expanding support for policy solutions that aren't just well-intended, but actually enhance people's freedom, opportunities, and well-being.

The Keep Our Girls Safe Act would direct the Department of Education to ensure that women and girls in federally funded educational settings—including all public schools and most colleges—have access to single-sex changing facilities. The bill will support President Trump's [executive order](#), which declared his administration will "take all appropriate action to affirmatively protect all-female athletic opportunities and all-female locker rooms and thereby provide the equal opportunity guaranteed by Title IX of the Education Amendments Act of 1972."

Over the past several years, far too many women and girls around the country have been forced to cede their intimate spaces to men in the name of "inclusion." Women and girls deserve to be able to play sports and exercise without fearing that their rights will be trampled upon or that their privacy will be violated.

It is imperative that the federal government hold accountable all institutions that receive federal funding, and ensure that they are complying with Title IX and with President Trump's executive order. Representative Miller's bill does just that.

For these reasons, we urge Congress to work toward the swift passage of this bill. Thank you, Representative Miller, for your leadership on this important issue.
